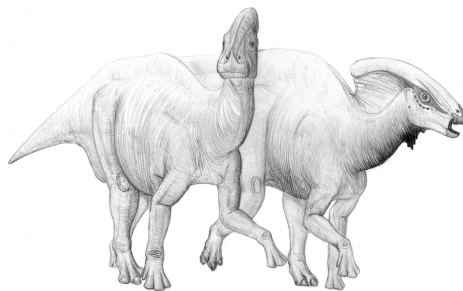




What's Happening at Ecolinc Science Centre 17-23 Labilliere Street, Bacchus Marsh in Science Week?

Primary School students are invited to a talk by one of Australia's well known palaeontologists, Dr Stephen Poropat (no cost) on
Thursday 16th August
4.30pm – 6.00pm

Come and learn about what is it like to be a palaeontologist? How do you become one? If these are the sorts of questions that you find yourself asking, palaeontologist Stephen Poropat might have some answers! Stephen will talk about how he became a palaeontologist, how he first became involved in digging up dinosaurs, and how he sees the future of palaeontology in Australia. Stephen will also talk about some of the major finds made in Australia - and where he expects future finds to be made! Maybe they'll be made by you...?



Students will also participate in an activity such as:

- Fossil dig – uncover a range of megafauna fossil skeletons
- Frozen Fossils – chip away and find a dinosaur frozen in time
- Craft activities – create a group collage about dinosaurs and where they roamed, create origami dinosaurs and lots more.
